### LIZ S. MIRANDA CECOM Integrated Logistics Support Center



Ms. Liz Miranda assumed the responsibility of Director of the CECOM Integrated Logistics Support Center in November 2015. As the Director of the CECOM ILSC, serves as the command's senior leader in developing a vision, strategy and implementation plans necessary to achieve an integrated enterprise approach to logistics for Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) weapon systems. Ms. Miranda provides leadership and guidance to a global organization of more than 2,000 employees, in over 20 countries and 100 sites. She leads the seven directorates that form the LRC in core

competencies of national inventory control point, national maintenance point, security assistance to allied nations, production and industrial base management and planning, integrated logistics planning and execution, and field technical assistance.

Ms. Miranda earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration with concentration in Accounting from University of Puerto Rico in 1993 and a Master of Science in Management from Florida Institute of Technology in 2005. She began her government service as an accounting technician in the Regional Finance and Accounting Office in Kaiserslautern, Germany. In 1997, Ms. Miranda moved to the Communications-Electronics Command, Fort Monmouth, NJ as an accountant in the G8. In 2010, she was selected as the Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management/G8 and served as the principal staff officer and advisor to the CECOM Commanding General for integrated planning, programming, budgeting, financial management, managerial accounting, cost analysis, and civilian and military force management requirements.

Ms. Miranda also served as the Executive Officer to the Deputy to the Commanding General for Operations and Support, Chief of the Reset Plans and Execution Branch in the Logistics and Readiness Center (LRC), and Deputy Chief of the Army Reprogramming Analysis Team (ARAT) Program Office in the Software Engineering Center (SEC).

Ms. Miranda is a graduate of the APG Senior Leadership Cohort Program and the CECOM Executive Development Program. She is an Acquisition Professional, Level III certified in Business, Cost Estimating and Financial Management. She has also achieved DoD Financial Management Level III Certification and is a member of the American Society of Military Comptrollers.
