Virtual Reality Enhances Depot Training System for Painters

TOBYHANNA ARMY DEPOT, Pa. – Recent hi-tech upgrades to a depot training system are earning rave reviews for their “remarkably lifelike” recreation of military asset refinishing operations. Since 2008, Tobyhanna has used the Spray Technique Analysis and Research for Defense (STAR4D) system, which originated from a University of Northern Iowa program for the automotive refinishing sector. The training aid enables the depot to save money and reduce environmental waste by teaching the correct painting techniques in a classroom setting.
